Code 40 Purchased Services	 In order to maintain a sanitary environment and proper social distancing, the school will take part in the following measures – Semi-annual deep cleaning of its building at a cost of \$3k per session in FY22. Total cost - \$6,000 Disinfecting services every other weekend at each building at \$1,000 to \$1,100 per session depending on location for an approximate total cost of \$22,100 Regular weekly Covid testing at both locations at an expected cost of \$,3800/week over 29 weeks totaling \$110,200 in FY22. Total cost for FY21 is \$7,560. Use the services on an architect to redesign ventilation system at a total cost of \$4,875. Cost includes meetings with school and sketch work. Install 35 exhaust fans throughout the MS building for a total installation cost of \$2,616. In order to ensure students have internet access at all times, the school is paying for hotspot services at a cost of \$440 per month, for a period of 19 months at a cost of \$8,360. The school uses Google voice to communicate with families. The cost for 75 licenses at \$120/license and \$34.68 in fees for each licenses is \$11,601. The school will maintain this service for a period of two years at a total cost of \$23,302.
